

CIS STATUS CARD LAMINATED PAPER VERSION PROCESSED AT GGC OFFICE

- REQUIRE TWO VALID PIECES OF I.D.:

 FOR AGE 16+ ONE VALID PICTURE I.D. AND ONE OTHER VALID ID

 FOR AGE 15- REQUIRE ONE VALID ID AND APPLYING PARENT REQUIRES 2 VALID ID
- MUST RETURN LAST ISSUED STATUS CARD

SCIS NEW SECURE STATUS CARD (SCIS) PROCESSED BY MAIL (takes 2-4 months)

- CAN TAKE PHOTO ON NEW SCIS PHOTO APP OR YOU CAN PROVIDE TWO PASSPORT PHOTOS
- A VALID GOVERNMENT ISSUED PICTURE ID: FOR AGE 16+ REQUIRE ONE VALID GOVERNMENT ISSUED PICTURE ID FOR AGE 15- APPLYING PARENT/GUARDIAN REQUIRES ONE VALID PICTURE ID

<u>CIS AND SCIS Card Admin Fee:</u> \$10- (AGE 16+)/ \$5- Children(15-) /\$15-Members of other Bands OR BRING RECENT SUITABLE PHOTO FOR CIS OR PASSPORT PHOTOS for SCIS.

Note there will be times that we will not have a supply of the old CIS cards for issuing SO MEMBERS ARE ENCOURAGED TO APPLY FOR THE NEW SCIS:

INDIAN ACT/BAND MEMBERSHIP REGISTRY:

REQUIRE ORIGINAL BIRTH CERTIFICATE (MUST state parent(s) names) APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION SIGNED BY BOTH PARENTS APPLYING PARENT-MUST PROVIDE VALID PICTURE ID

Important to register Children ASAP after birth, SHOULD have "status" registry number BYAGE 2 YEARS, to continue to be eligible for First Nations health benefits through Health Canada and/or FNHA.

Donna Alexcee-Employment Assistant Worker for Gitsegukla, Gitwangak and Gitanyow

Greetings everyone,

Just a brief update on my position as Employment Assistant Worker.

This year marks 12 years working for Tricorp (Prince Rupert) and stationed here in Gitsegukla.

My work is on contract, every year they renew it, so this keeps me wondering what are they going to do with me this year. When I first started working for them, there was 21 of us who went training in Prince Rupert to work as Assistant worker. Out of 21 of us, I'm the only one left working as EAS worker for Tricorp.

I enjoy what I do, and that is assisting Gitsegukla community members on and off reserve that reside in Tricorps region. Throughout the years working, I've seen many of Gitsegukla's Youth get in to the work force. Having the summer employment program every year helps the high school students experience what it's like to work and to earn a pay cheque and to leave their comfort zone. Right now, I'm getting them ready for summer employment. This year, there is going to be 12 high school students on board. First group will start on Monday, June 30th, and the 2nd group will start August 4th, 2025. I have 3 different sponsors this year, which is awesome. Some may be working in the offices answering phones, so bare with them.

It was awesome to get the Heavy Equipment Training program here back in March 2025. This was a great learning experience for the guys/gals who got the training. Just for your info, Tricorp will be checking in on how your doing, if the program has helped you gain employment.

This past year, FNESC sponsored 3 students, not in school or returning to school, to be employed for 5 to 6 months.

I'm thankful for FNESC and TRICORP for their sponsorships in putting high school students to work every summer. Without that, students wouldn't be able to get the training in what they want to do in their future careers, most of all is leaving their comfort zone (home)
